An economically leading Gewog with a cohesive society, vibrant culture, sound environment and balanced development.

Mission

Provide conducive environment for diversified economic activities for the well being of people in the Gewog.

Background

Established in 2016, Metabkha is one of the smallest gewog in Chukha Dzongkhag. The gewog is administratively divided into 5 chewogs with a geographical area of 100 Sq Km with 15 villages, 119 households and 1036 population. The altitude of the gewog ranges from 1500 meters above sea level with sub tropical and temperate climatic condition.

The Gewog has a record of 100% primary enrolment, 100% of households electrified, 100% mobile coverage, 94% of households has access to safe drinking water and 100 % households have toilets. However, 46% of the population are illiterate, 14.16 % (17 households) experiences food insufficiency, and 4.16 % (5 households) has to walk more than half an hour to reach nearest road head.

The gewog has a total of 770.23 acres of dry land and 116.230 acres of wet land, 22.501 acres of cardamom land, and 0.180 acres of oranges land with good internal farm road connectivity measuring 20 km and is connected with Dungna and Geling gewog, 1 youth group, 1 farmers group with supply of 4 power tillers, 10 boleros, 1 DCM and 7 well constructed irrigation channels. The gewog has immense potential for following development:

- I. Poultry and dairy farming
- II. Farm mechanization for mass production of off -season vegetables & cereal crops & fruit plants development.
