Phuntsholing Dungkhag Administration

Phuntsholing Dungkhag Administration comprises of 4 Gewogs, namely, Darla, Lockchina, Phuntsholing and Sampheling. The Dungkhag Administration is located in the heart of the Thromde Administration between latitude 26⁰51'35" and longitude 89⁰23'14" at an elevation of 780 feet (237.7) above sea level.

The total area of Dungkhag is 428.76 Km² and has 20,332 people. There are 21 Chiwogs, 70 villages and 1765 households.

There are 391 Civil Servants, 4 Gups, 4 Mangmis and 21 Tshogpas spread within the jurisdiction of Dungkhag.





Civil servants within Dungkhag




