## Background

Covering an area of 1879.5 Sq. Km with elevation ranging from 200-3500 m above sea level, Chhukha Dzongkhag was established in 1987. Administratively divided into 11 Gewogs, 58 Chiwogs, Drungkhag and Thromdey, it has total of 16,075 households and 123 villages with 68966 population .

As per the Population and Housing Census of Bhutan 2017, 97% of households in Chhukha have access to nearest road head in less than 30 minutes, 75.1 % of regular population of Chhukha are literate, 97.8 % of households are access to improved water sources and 74.6 % of the rural population are access to improved sanitation.

As of June 2018, there are 1289 Civil Servants in the Dzongkhag comprising of 398 Civil Servants in Professional and Management level, 334 Civil Servants in Supervisory and Support level, 66 in Operational level and 229 in para regulars.

Chhukha is the main entry points for import and commercial hub of the country. Major hydro power plants, which are key source of national income are also located in Chhukha Dzongkhag. This comparative advantage can foster rapid economic growth of the Dzongkhag.

The rough terrain of land topography, far flung scattered villages, heavy monsoon rainfall, foggy weather, high poverty incidences and poor health sanitation issues are some of the challenges that hamper the smooth implementation of the planned activi-
